Payment may be made on Aride Island by credit card. Opening days are on Sun, Mon & Wed. Please note that visitors are not permitted to land on the island by any means other than the reserve boats. Landings commence at 1000hrs, with departure at 1530hrs. The island is generally closed between June and August due to strong onshore seas. There is a 200 metre limit around Aride Island Nature Reserve, fishing within this area is NOT permitted. It is against Seychelles Law to deliberately disturb any of the birds on Aride Island Nature Reserve. We ask you not to disturb any of them, especially the Frigatebirds which roost around the back of the island. Do not get too close, or make sudden loud noises. Vessels approaching Aldabra must identify themselves and when within one kilometre of the shore will be answerable to the Warden of Aldabra. The vessel should select its anchorage or make use of existing mooring buoys within view of the research station and do so in an environmentally responsible way.
